The committee opposed the proposed allotment of co-supervisors for those students who have left the campus. For future such cases it was proposed that for students who have completed their residency or completed their open seminar and whose supervisor goes on a long leave then the Convener DPGC/ Chairman-DPGC would act as the *caretaker supervisor for the student*. **This may be placed in the senate as an agenda.**

**Item No.4 Adopting of MHRD GO F.No.17-2/2014-T.S.-1 dated 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2015 regarding the Scholarship of PhD students (corrections to the minutes of the 3<sup>rd</sup> senate meeting)**

As per the discussion in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Senate meeting held on 17/10/2015 it was decided that the transition from 04 years scholarship to 05 years scholarship as per the above mentioned GO would not be done automatically. The student will have to be assessed by a committee, before final extension of the scholarship. As this has been wrongly minuted in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Senate minutes of the meeting therefore, this is for further ratification in the 4<sup>th</sup> Senate meeting. **This corrigendum may be placed in the senate as an agenda item in the 4<sup>th</sup> senate.**

**Item No.5 To discuss the modalities with reference to the new proposed M.Tech program to be started in the forthcoming semester.**

In the 2<sup>nd</sup> SPGC meeting and the academic council meeting held thereafter it was agreed to discontinue M .Tech (WCE) and again resume both original courses M.Tech (IT) with specialization in WCC and M.Tech (ECE) with specialization in Communication Engineering.

SPGC resolves to resume the programmes and seat allocation maybe done. The ECE department was asked to give a self contained proposal for further discussion in the senate. **This may be placed in the senate as an agenda.**

**Item No.6. Any other point to be taken up (if suggested) DPGC conveners or by SPGC chair.**

- DPGC (AS)—Request for approval of combining subjects which are similar in syllabus like Biostatistics (code: SBSS-730C) for M Tech BME 7th Sem and Biomathematics and Statistics (code: SBMS-131M) for M Tech-BI 1<sup>st</sup> Semester.

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In general was agreed that combining of subjects with similar syllabus be done inorder to avoid waste of time.

- DPGC (Management)- agenda for discussion
  - It was agreed that the subjects Principle of Economics (MPOE-03 credits) and Principle of Management (MPOM-03 credits) were required to remain the same. The course structure should be reviewed and case study module to be added.
  - SPGC agreed to the allow the minor modification in the course structure of BCP & DRP running in MBA 4<sup>th</sup> semester
  
- SPGC- item for consideration: Regarding grace period of 45 days

As per the decision of the 19<sup>th</sup> RDC meeting Item No. 9 it was decided that a grace period of 45 days from the beginning of the semester be given to candidates who are about to submit their thesis.

The matter was discussed and it was decided that since financial matters are outside the purview of the SPGC, therefore the fees related matter can be taken up by Dean (Academics)/advisory committee of the institute and decide the fees submission related process.
