Minutes of 10th meeting of the SUGC

The 10th meeting of SUGC was held on 15/11/2016 in Exam Cell at 3:30 PM. The following members were present:

The issues discussed and the resolutions made were as follows:

1. To confirm the minutes of the 9th meeting held on September 12, 2016.

The minutes of the 9th SUGC were confirmed.

2. To consider the application of Mr. Shivam Kumar (IIT2013104) enrolled to Simulation and Modeling in 7th semester in current ongoing session without clearing the course on Probability and Statistics. (IT Dept).

The requirement of pre-requisite was already discussed in previous Senate Meeting. The decision of the senate will be binding on all the students.

3. Consideration of the request of Mr. Saptak Sengupta (IIT2013193) who has given application for 6 month research project in NTU. (IT Dept)

The request of Mr. Saptak Sengupta will be discussed in next SUGC Meeting after considering UG Ordinance. DR (A) shall be requested to make the Ordinances available on Institute's website for wider publication as per previous Senate decision.

4. Consideration of the request of Mr. Varsheindra Gautam (IEC2012071) regarding conducting the re-examination for IDCO730. (ECE Dept)

The request of Mr. Varsheindra Gautam to allow him to appear for re-examination for IDCO730E, who has failed two times in this course, was discussed by the members of the committee. It was decided to advise the concerned student to file an appeal to Senate through DUGC.

5. Short Attendance Case of Mr. Irfan Irshad (IBM2014002) & Mr. Anish Kumar Sahu (IMM2014008) (ECE Dept)

The case of short attendance for Mr. Irfan Irshad and Mr. Anish Kumar Sahu was discussed in the meeting. It was pointed that the appeal of Mr. Irfan Irshad was already accepted by Senate in its 4th meeting. It was decided that the case of Mr. Anish Kr Sahu should be dealt as per policy.

6. Consideration of the suggestions for betterment in academic calendar. (ECE Dept.)

The members recommended forming of an advisory committee to the Dean (Acad) with wider representation in the preparation of Academic Calendar. The following suggestions may be considered while preparation:

- The period of mid semester break may be added to winter break.
- There should be equal number of days (Monday-Friday) in the semester. The loss of any particular day due to institute's Holiday should be compensated by predefined day conversions.
- There should be pre-declared additional holidays, e.g., the day after the convocation, effervescence, sports meets, foundation day, etc.

7. Consideration of the proposal for CGPA/SGPA Conversion into Percentage.

For various reasons such as applying for higher studies, jobs, scholarship, existing and passed out students of IIIT Allahabad require percentage of marks they have obtained in their academic programme. Currently, there is no provision to award percentage certificate or method of calculation for the same. Many other Institute award equivalence percentage certificate of the CGPI they obtain in their programme (Enclosed).

The SUGC discussed in length and recommended the following formula for CGPI/SGPI conversion into percentage for all passed out and current students.

Notional percentage over course = $(CGPI \times 10) - 1$

Notional percentage over semester = $(SGPI \times 10) - 1$


(i.e., CGPI of 8.93 and SGPI of 9.25 to have notional percentages of 89.2% and 92.4% respectively.)


8. Any other issue with the permission of the chair.
